TITLE: Store/Restaurant Dining Policy

Description

The following policy defines the District’s acceptable standard regarding personnel going to stores/markets and dining facilities for meals while on-duty.

Policy

Personnel shall only pick-up food from restaurants and grocery stores to take back to their respective fire station for consumption. Dining in a restaurant will no longer be allowed without the permission of Management.

The following shall be adhered to while patronizing stores and dining establishments:

- Engine companies shall only patronize businesses in their primary response area. (A business on the opposite side of the road from your response area is acceptable).
- Personnel shall be in District Class B uniform shirt, uniform pant and uniform jacket in cold weather. (T-shirts, sweat shirts, turnouts, non-District clothing, etc. are not allowed).
- Personnel not dressed per policy shall remain on the apparatus.
- Meals shall only be purchased/consumed during non-designated business hours. (Before 0800 hours, 1130-1300 hours and after 1600 hours). (Exceptions made for emergency incidents & District business).
- Engine companies performing stand-by duties shall only patronize businesses in the area they’re covering.
- The ability to respond to emergency incidents shall not be compromised when patronizing local businesses.
- Dining at restaurants may be authorized by Management when it benefits the interests of the District.

Any deviation from this policy shall be with the permission of District Management.
