TITLE: Parking Policy

PURPOSE

To establish a risk management and customer service approach in relation to private and District owned vehicle parking.

POLICY

Personal Vehicles

Parking of personal vehicles on District property is prohibited in other than designated appropriate parking areas. Parking in front of in-service apparatus bay doors is strictly prohibited with the only exception being permission granted by a chief officer. Parking of personal vehicles in apparatus rooms is prohibited.

Exceptions

- During shift change between the hours of 0630 and 0730 (2nd out bay doors)
- Permission granted by a chief officer.
- During projects such as construction or parking lot maintenance or repair.
- So we may better serve our customers, District employees working at Fire Administration and Station 36 are prohibited from parking their vehicles in the three spaces in front of Headquarters, Monday through Friday, 0600-1800 hours.

District Owned Vehicles

Parking of District vehicles on District property is authorized in appropriate parking areas and the apparatus room bays as available.

District vehicles are not to be parked in front of in-service apparatus bay doors.

Exceptions

- Duty B/C, Operations Chief and/or the Fire Chief may park in front of Bay 1 at Station 36.

- Duty B/C, Operations Chief and/or the Fire Chief may park in front of Bay 1 at Station 34, when parking is limited.
- During projects such as construction or parking lot maintenance or repair.
- Short term needs such as loading or unloading.
- So we may better serve our customers, District employees driving District vehicles working at Fire Administration and Station 36, are prohibited from parking their vehicles in the center parking space in front of Headquarters, Monday through Friday, 0600-1800 hours.
